Our Mission is to educate, advocate, and collaborate with community partners to strengthen our voice in mental health causes.

Activities / Services

- Engages individuals and groups to support the development of local support groups.
- Works in collaboration with the other program staff and partners to identify agencies to conduct outreach.
- Works with the Regional Resource Centers to identify support group needs and provide support as needed.
- Facilitates group trainings.
- Engages and works with mental health centers every quarter to educate clinicians and staff around issues of peer support and recovery.
- Plans and hosts the annual Kansas Recovery Conference bringing together people in mental health and addiction recovery and support organizations.
- Facilitates a Leadership Academy for those with lived experience of behavioral health diagnoses who want to gain skills in participating in/leading community groups.
- Partners with state, national and international organizations on projects in support of peers and our mission.
- Give input on issues and legislation that affect peers in Kansas.

How We Make A Difference

- 201 people from 54 counties attended the Kansas Recovery Conference in 2017
- 167 graduates of Leadership Academy across the state, 12 people participated in Peer Leadership Education for Empowerment last year;
- Met with CRO Leaders from 13 counties 3 times last year
- Gave input to the Governor's Behavioral Health Planning Council and KDADS
